He has also had international experience between 2011 and 2014 in Kosovo, formerly part of Yugoslavia, where he was responsible for writing the Standard Operating Procedure for the management of organized crime in Kosovo.

Mr Martin is no stranger to the Turks and Caicos Islands. Previously, he was the senior investigator and intelligence officer between 2014 and 2016, tasked with investigating public sector corruption and money laundering by public officials in these Islands.
